Meier Supply adds Harrisburg location

HVAC distributor's site is firm's 14th

JOHNSON CITY — Meier Supply Company, Inc., a wholesale distributor of heating, cooling, ventilation, and refrigeration products, has opened a new branch in Harrisburg, Pa.

The Harrisburg store, located at 2359 Woodlawn Ave.,

is the 14th branch store for the family-run employee-owned company. Bernadette Meier, company spokeswoman, says the Harrisburg store building has 15,000 square feet of floor space. Meier is using 10,000 square feet and leases the remaining 5,000 square feet to a tenant.

The company's headquarters remains at 123 Brown St., Johnson City, where it also has a 36,000-square-foot distribution center.

Meier Supply Company, Inc. is celebrating its 50th anniversary next year. The company has 96 full-time and 15 part-time associates, and four generations of the Meier's family have been a part of the company. Today, Frank Meier, Jr. is a third-generation Meier with the company, and serves as its president and CEO.

"We are totally committed to our mission statement: 'Customer satisfaction guaranteed,'" says Frank Meier, Jr.

Barry Kepner, who previously served Meier Supply customers in Williamsport and Altoona, Pa., will serve as branch manager of the Harrisburg store.

Kepner has more than 20 years experience in HVAC and refrigeration, including 10 years working for Pameco Corporation and Makdad Industrial Supply in the Harrisburg area.

Meier's father, Frank A. Meier, Sr., and grandfather, Frank M. Meier, found-

ed the company in 1957 on Court Street in downtown Binghamton.

Today, Meier Supply has branch locations in Binghamton, Syracuse, Utica, Buffalo, Middletown, and Rochester. Locations in Pennsylvania include Allentown, Altoona, Erie, Scranton, Stroudsburg, Wilkes-Barre, and Williamsport.

Meier became an employee-

owned company in 1992.

Bernadette Meier says the company continues to grow, and additional branches likely will open in coming years, noting the company has been adding a new store each year for the past several years. Meier Supply's annual revenue exceeds \$30 million. □
